

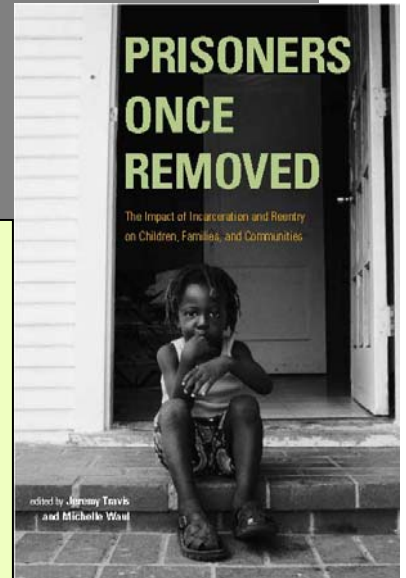


Prisoners Once Removed
