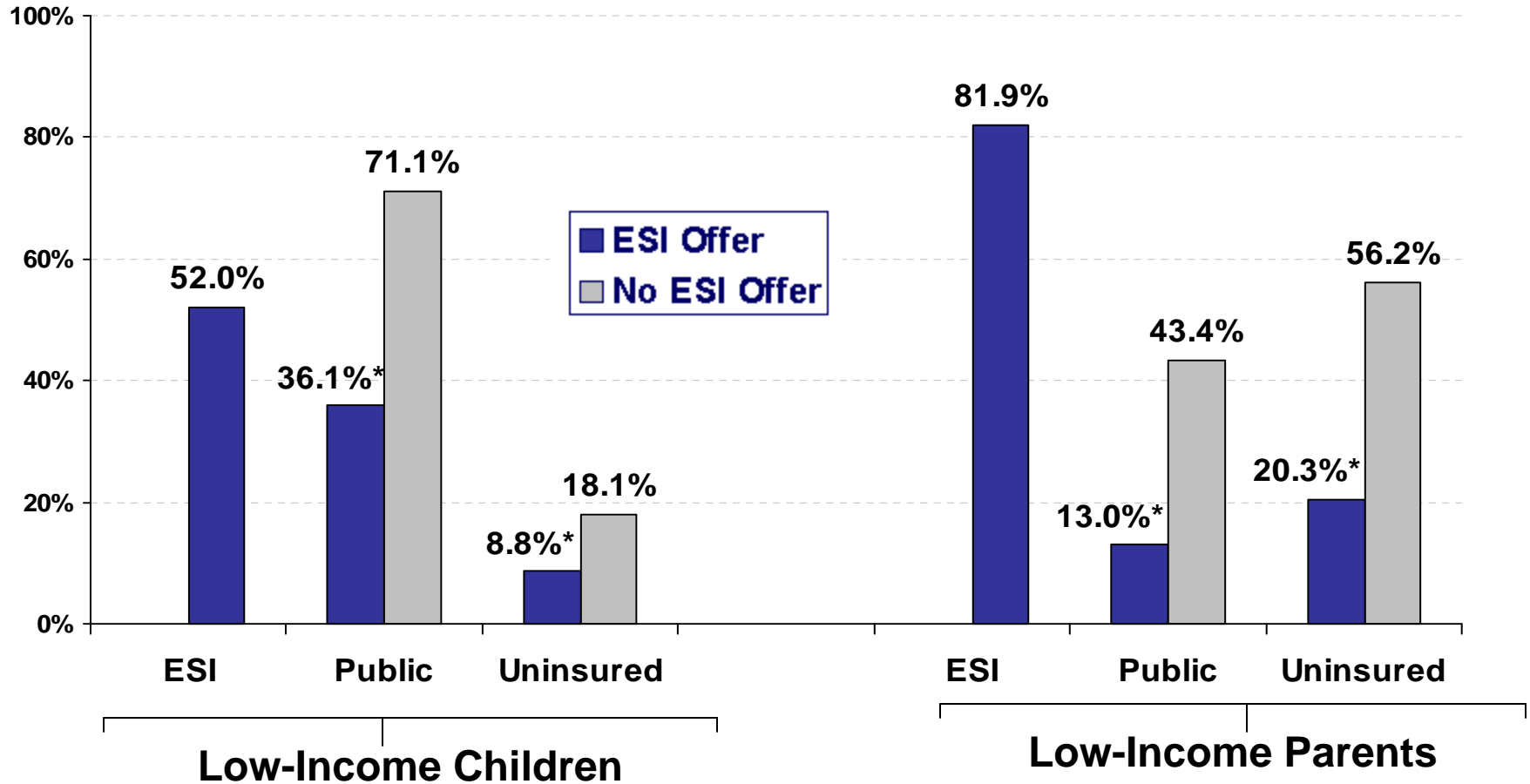


# Insurance Status Among Low-Income Children and Parents in Families with and without ESI offers
