### **Summer 2009 Class**

The application and the letter of recommendation are interactive .pdf files--You can type directly onto the pdf files. However, unless you have Adobe Acrobat Professional, you will not be able to save and edit your answers. You can either 1) fill out the form all at once and print it (highly preferred), or 2) print the form and fill it in by hand (please write legibly).

***In order to be considered. Application packages must be postmarked by March 12, 2009 and contain all items in the documents checklist.***
