



**1b. Do Work Requirements Affect Benefit Applications by Potentially Eligible Families?**


Some potentially eligible people may not apply for benefits or continue to participate in safety net programs because of concerns or confusion about work requirements.






**2b. Who Is Exempt from Work Requirements?**




