


# Renters Impacted by CDC Temporary Eviction Moratorium

# The CDC Eviction Moratorium

- Applies to counties or territories experiencing **substantial** or **high** levels of community transmission.
- Individuals must earn no more than \$99,000 (or \$198,000 if filing jointly) in Calendar Year 2020 or expects to earn no more than that in Calendar Year 2021.
- Will remain in effect through October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021.

325,000 renter households not covered


23,000 renter households likely to be evicted and not covered
