Infection preventionists perform and oversee infection prevention and control efforts in health care facilities and other settings where groups of people gather. They analyze data about the facility and community to understand how infections occur and spread, establish policies and procedures to reduce infections, and develop targeted interventions to ensure a safe environment.
