



National Occupational Framework: Stamping Press Operator

Stamping press operators set up and operate machines that cut, bend, shape, or straighten metal or plastic material. They set up and adjust machines according to blueprints, operate equipment to cut and shape material, and inspect and test finished products. They also perform equipment maintenance and make repairs when finished products do not meet standards.
